AN ORDINANCE to amend the Port Services (Dues, Charges and Management) Ordinance, Ch. 18. No. 2.

[On Proclamation]

Commencement

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof. Enactment

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Port Services (Dues, Charges and Management) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Port Services (Dues, Charges and Management) Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Short title

(2) This Ordinance shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Governor by Proclamation in the *Royal Gazette*.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) by deleting the definition of the word "Basin" therein;
- (b) in the definition of "wharf premises", by inserting immediately after the word "Port-of-Spain" the words "or Scarborough";
- (c) in the definition of "wharf", by inserting immediately after the word "Port-of-Spain" the words "or Scarborough", and by adding immediately after the words and symbols "King's Wharf" the words "and Scarborough Wharf";
- (d) by inserting in the said section in their appropriate alphabetical order the following definitions:—

"Port-of-Spain Basin" means the dredged portion of the harbour of Port-of-Spain abutting on King's Wharf but does not include the dredged channel leading to such dredged portion;

"Scarborough Basin" means the dredged portion of the harbour of Scarborough abutting on Scarborough Wharf but does not include the dredged channel leading to such dredged portion."

3. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) in subsection (1) by inserting immediately after the word "harbour" occurring in line 3 thereof the words "or Scarborough harbour";
- (b) in subsection (3) by inserting immediately after the words "King's Wharf" occurring in line 2 thereof the words "or at Scarborough Wharf";
- (c) in subsection (4) by inserting immediately after the words "Port-of-Spain harbour" occurring in line 1 thereof the words "or in Scarborough harbour".

4. Subsection (1) of section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting for all the words, punctuation marks and symbols preceding paragraph (a) thereof the following:—

"In the case of any vessel (not being a drogher) berthed at King's Wharf or at Scarborough Wharf or moored or anchored in the Port-of-Spain Basin or the

Scarborough Basin, Basin dues (in addition to harbour dues and to any wharf dues, which may be payable) shall be paid on—”.

5. Section 14 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting for the words “into the Treasury to the credit of the Port-of-Spain Wharves” appearing therein the words “to the credit of the Port Services Department”.

6. Subsection (1) of section 15 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting for the word “Basin” occurring in line 5 thereof the words “Port-of-Spain Basin or the Scarborough Basin”.

7. Section 17 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting for the word “Basin” wherever it appears therein the words “Port-of-Spain Basin or the Scarborough Basin”.

8. Paragraph (3) of Schedule II to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the words “King’s Wharf” the words “or when berthed at Scarborough Wharf”.

9. Paragraph (4) of Schedule II to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the words “at Port-of-Spain” the words “or at Scarborough Wharf”.
