AN ORDINANCE to provide for the refund of the contributions made under the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance by George James formerly an officer in the Fire Services Department.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the Enactment. advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Widows' and Short title. Orphans' Pensions (Refund of Contributions to George James) Ordinance, 1956.

Authority
for refund of
contributions.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary the Accountant General shall, on the warrant of the Governor, pay out of general revenue to George James, formerly an officer in the Fire Services Department of the Colony, the sum of one hundred and two dollars and five cents being the amount of the contributions made under the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance by the said officer between the 1st day of November, 1951 and the 15th day of August, 1953.

Dependents

3. Upon the commencement of this Ordinance, the said George James shall cease to enjoy the privileges and benefits of a contributor under the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance in respect of the contributions directed by this Ordinance to be refunded, and the wife and children of the said George James shall no longer have any claims to pension under the said Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance in respect of the said contributions.
