AN ORDINANCE to amend the Arima Corporation Ordinance,
Ch. 39. No. 11.

[8th December, 1955.]

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago, with Enactment.
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Arima Corporation Short title.
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be read as one with
the Arima Corporation Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as Ch. 39. No. 11.

2. Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) in subsection (2)—

(i) by substituting the figures and words “31st of March” for the figures and words “15th of June” wherever those figures and words occur in the said subsection ; and

(ii) by substituting the following paragraph for paragraph (c) thereof :—

“(c) is, on the 31st of March, and has been during the whole of the preceding twelve months, resident within the borough.” ; and

(b) by repealing subsection (3) thereof.

Section 56 of

replaced.

3. The following section is hereby substituted for section 56 of the Principal Ordinance :—

“Town Clerk
to make up
burgess list.

56. (1) The Town Clerk shall, on or before the 30th of June in each year, make out a list, to be called the burgess list, of all persons who are entitled to be enrolled as burgesses for the year within the borough and shall sign such list.

(2) The list shall distinguish in separate parts the persons entitled to be enrolled as burgesses in respect of qualifying property or in respect of residence, as the case may be.”

4. Sections 57 and 58 of the Principal Ordinance are hereby repealed.

5. Section 59 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) in subsection (1), by deleting the words and comma “including the list of burgesses qualified in respect of the occupation of lodgings,” ; and

(b) by substituting for subsection (2) thereof the following—

“(2) The burgess list shall be in the form A in the Fourth Schedule, or in such other form as the Council may from time to time prescribe.”

6. The Fourth Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) by deleting Forms A, B and C ;

(b) by inserting as Form A thereof the following :—

(d) in Form E, by substituting for the words “Description of property for which he is a Burgess” the words “No. and situation of property, or address(es) of residence, in respect of which objector is qualified as a burgess” ;

(e) by substituting for Forms F and G respectively the following forms :—

7. The amendments specified in the second column of the Schedule to this Ordinance (which relate to consequential or minor matters) shall respectively be made in the sections of the Principal Ordinance specified in the first column of the said Schedule.

Application.

8. (1) The provisions of this Ordinance shall have effect in relation to the making out of the burgess list and the compilation of the burgess roll in the year 1956 and in succeeding years, and, subject to the provisions of section 13 of the Principal Ordinance, in relation to the election of Councillors in the year 1956 at any time after the coming into operation of the said burgess roll and in succeeding years.

(2) Nothing in this Ordinance shall affect the validity of—

- (a) any burgess roll compiled under the provisions of the Principal Ordinance before the coming into operation of the burgess roll to be compiled in the year 1956, or
- (b) the election of any Councillor elected before the coming into operation of the burgess roll to be compiled in the year 1956.
