AN ORDINANCE to amend further the Wild Animals and Birds (Protection) Ordinance, Ch. 25. No. 7.

[31st December, 1955.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Wild Animals and Birds (Protection) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Wild Animals and Birds (Protection) Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Short title.

New section

2. After section 20 of the Principal Ordinance the following section, numbered 20A, shall be inserted—

"Right of  
Game Warden  
to conduct  
case.

20A. Where any Game Warden makes a complaint against any person for an offence under this Ordinance, any other Game Warden may appear before the Magistrate who is trying or enquiring into the matter of the said complaint, and shall have the same privileges as to addressing the said Magistrate and as to examining the witnesses adduced in the said matter as the Game Warden who made the complaint would have had."
