AN ORDINANCE to amend the Governor's Emoluments Ordinance, Ch. 9. No. 1.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Governor's Emoluments (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Governor's Emoluments Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(2) This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of June, 1956.

2. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance as enacted by the Governor's Emoluments (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, is hereby amended—

- (a) by re-numbering the same as subsection (1) of section 6; and
- (b) by adding at the end thereof the following new subsection to be numbered (2):—

“(2) In the absence of the Governor from the Colony on duty, the officer administering the Government shall receive—

- (i) an amount equal to ninety-five per cent. of the salary attached to the office of Governor; and
- (ii) a duty allowance equal to the duty allowance attached to the office of Governor.”

3. For the purposes of computing any salary or duty allowance payable in pursuance of this Ordinance to the officer administering the Government in respect of any part of the year 1956, there shall be taken into account any salary or duty allowance already paid to him in respect of the said part of the said year. Adjustment.

Passed in Council this fourteenth day of December, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six.
