AN ORDINANCE to amend the County Councils Ordinance,
Ch. 39. No. 15.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the County Councils (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be read as one with the County Councils Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Addition of new
subsection
to section 115
of Principal
Ordinance.

2. Section 115 of the Principal Ordinance, as enacted by the County Councils (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, is hereby amended by the addition, immediately after subsection (2) thereof, of the following new subsection, to be numbered (3):—

“(3) The several offices of Chairman of a County Council, member of a County Council, and appointed member of a Committee of a County Council, shall not be offices of emolument under the Crown for any of the purposes of the Trinidad and Tobago (Constitution) Order in Council, 1950.”

Passed in Council this twenty-fifth day of May, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six.
