AN ORDINANCE to make special provision for the grant of pensions to the illegitimate children of Carlyle Mosley Pigott, deceased, former Corporal in the Police Force of the Colony.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Carlyle Mosley Pigott (Special Pensions) Ordinance, 1956.

Short title.

Authority

2. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary, there may be paid out of general revenue to Marva, born on the first day of January, 1953, and to Michael, born on the third day of July, 1955, the illegitimate children of Carlyle Mosley Pigott, deceased, former Corporal in the Police Force of the Colony, and of Sylvia MacCarthy, each a pension at the rate of seventy-five dollars per annum as from the 6th day of August, 1955.

(2) The pension payable to the said Marva shall cease upon her attaining the age of eighteen years or upon her marriage under the said age.

(3) The pension payable to the said Michael shall cease upon his attaining the age of eighteen years.

Passed in Council this twenty-fifth day of May, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six.
