2. Section 15 of the Principal Ordinance, as enacted by the Gambling (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952-1953, is hereby amended—

- (a) by substituting for the words “a Superintendent of Police” occurring in the eleventh and twelfth lines thereof the words and stop “any other Gazetted Police Officer not below the rank of Assistant Superintendent for the time being attached to the division in which such bazaar, fancy fair or entertainment is proposed to be held”; and
- (b) by substituting for the words “Superintendent of Police” occurring in the fifteenth line thereof the words and stops, “such other Gazetted Police Officer, as the case may be,”.

Passed in Council this thirtieth day of November, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six.
