Act No. 15 of 1965

AN ACT to provide that James Valdez be deemed to have been accepted as a contributor under the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance, Ch. 9. No. 8.

[Assented to 4th August, 1965]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Widows' and Orphans' Short title Pensions (James Valdez) Act. 1965.

Interpretation

2. In this Act—

“Committee” means the Public Service Widows’ and Orphans’ Pensions Committee established by section 4 of the Ordinance;

“Ordinance” means the Widows’ and Orphans’ Pensions Ordinance.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Ordinance, James Valdez, deceased, a former attendant attached to the Ministry of Health shall be deemed to have been entitled to the privileges and benefits of a contributor under the said Ordinance, with effect from the 1st day of November, 1961, as if he had consented to be rated up as a life equal to twelve years older than his actual age on the 1st day of November, 1961, and had been accepted by the Committee as a contributor on that condition.

No refund of contributions to be made

4. No refund shall be made of any abatement from the salary of the said James Valdez retained by the Accountant General as a contribution under the Ordinance pending his acceptance by the Committee as a contributor.
