**Act No. 22 of 1965**

AN ACT to amend section 14 of the Constitution of  
Trinidad and Tobago

*[Assented to 6th November, 1965]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, **Enactment**  
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and  
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and  
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Trinidad and Tobago short title  
Constitution (Amendment) Act, 1965.

2. Section 14 of the Constitution is hereby amended by adding immediately after subsection (4) thereof the following subsections:—

“(5) Subsections (1) and (2) of this section shall not apply to a person who, having become a citizen of Trinidad and Tobago by virtue of section 9 of this Constitution does not cease to be a citizen of the United Kingdom and Colonies by virtue of subsection (3) of section 2 of the Trinidad and Tobago Independence Act, 1962.

(6) Subsection (5) shall be deemed to have had effect from the 31st August, 1962.”
