Act No. 22 of 1964

AN ACT to provide for Supplementary Appropriation for the Service of Trinidad and Tobago for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1964.

[Assented to 16th October, 1964]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Third Supplementary Short title Appropriation Act, 1964.

2. A further issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of eight million, two hundred and twenty-one thousand, four hundred and seventy-four dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1964 under the Heads of expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the said Schedule opposite to a Head is hereby appropriated out of the said sum of eight million, two hundred and twenty-one thousand, four hundred and seventy-four dollars for the purposes specified in relation to that Head in the Estimates for the said year.
