TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 13 of 1964

[L.S.]

AN ACT to amend the Constitution of
Trinidad and Tobago.

[Assented to 17th July, 1964]

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (2) of section 14 of the Constitution of Trinidad and Tobago that persons who became citizens of Trinidad and Tobago on the 31st August, 1962, by virtue of the provisions of section 9 of the said Constitution and who immediately after that day are also citizens of some country other than Trinidad and Tobago, shall cease to be citizens of Trinidad and Tobago on the 31st August, 1964, unless before that date they have renounced such other citizenship:

And whereas the combined effect of subsection (2) of section 14 of the Constitution of Trinidad and Tobago and of section 2 of the Trinidad and Tobago Independence Act, 1962, is to cause a large number of persons who became citizens of Trinidad and Tobago by virtue of the provisions of section 9 of the said Constitution, to retain citizenship of the United Kingdom and Colonies, thus rendering themselves liable to the loss of citizenship of Trinidad and Tobago:

And whereas it has been found that the period allowed to such persons in which to renounce citizenship of such other country is too short to permit those of them who desire to renounce such other citizenship so to do:

And whereas it is desirable that the period be extended to the 31st day of August, 1967:

Enactment

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Trinidad and Tobago Constitution (Amendment) Act, 1964.

**Section 14(2) of
the Constitution
of Trinidad and
Tobago amended.**

2. Subsection (2) of section 14 of the Constitution of Trinidad and Tobago is hereby amended by substituting the words "31st August, 1967" for the words "31st August, 1964".
