TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 16 of 1964

[L.S.]

AN ACT to make provision for determining the basis on which a gratuity and pension should be computed in respect of George Inniss, a former Attendant Grade I, Ministry of Health and Housing.

[Assented to 17th July, 1964]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the George Inniss (Pension Short title and Gratuity) Act, 1964.

Basis of computation of gratuity and pension of George Inniss, former Attendant Grade I, Ministry of Health and Housing

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law relating to the granting of pensions or to the basis to be taken for the purpose of computing the amount of an officer's pension, gratuity or allowance, it is hereby declared that, for the purpose of computing the pension and gratuity payable to him, George Inniss, a former Attendant Grade I, Ministry of Health and Housing, shall be deemed at the date of his retirement to have been the holder of the office of Supervisor of Attendants, Ministry of Health and Housing, and to have been in receipt of the full pensionable emoluments in respect of that office.
