TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

**Act No. 17 of 1964**

[L.S.]

AN ACT to authorise the payment of an amount by way of gratuity and pension to Leo Cruickshank, formerly a member of the Trinidad and Tobago Police Force.

*[Assented to 17th July, 1964]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, <sup>Enactment</sup> by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Leo Cruickshank <sup>Short title</sup> (Gratuity and Pension) Act, 1964.

2. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary, there may be paid out of general revenue to Leo Cruickshank, formerly a member of the Trinidad and Tobago Police Force, with effect from the date of his retirement from the said Force, a sum by way of gratuity and an annual allowance computed as if the said Leo Cruickshank had held the rank of Sergeant of the Trinidad and Tobago Police Force at the date of his retirement.

(2) Any sums paid before the commencement of this Act to the said Leo Cruickshank by way of gratuity and annual allowance shall be set off against any sums to which he becomes entitled to be paid under subsection (1).
