TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 30 of 1964

[L.S.]

AN ACT to provide that Julien St. Louis, Robert G. Wilson, Charles Gotha, Hennessy Patterson, Errol Radix, Arthur N. Joseph and Philip McKenzie, formerly public officers in the public service of Trinidad and Tobago shall be deemed to have been accepted as contributors under the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance.

[Assented to on 23rd December, 1964]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Widows' and Orphans' (Miscellaneous Officers) Act, 1964.

Interpretation

2. In this Act—

“the Committee” means the Public Service Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Committee established by section 4 of the Ordinance ;

“the Ordinance” means the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance;

“public officer” means an officer named in the Schedule.

Officers mentioned in the Schedule deemed to have been accepted as contributors under the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Ordinance, a public officer shall be deemed to have been entitled to the privileges and benefits of a contributor under the Ordinance with effect from the 1st day of January, 1959, as if he had undergone a medical examination to the satisfaction of the Committee and had been accepted by the Committee as a contributor.

No refund of contributions to be made

4. No refund shall be made of any abatement retained by the Accountant General from the salary of a public officer as that officer's contributions under the Ordinance pending his acceptance by the Committee as a contributor.
