REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD TOBAGO Act No. 7 of 1992

[L.S.]

AN ACT to make special provision for the publication and revision of the list of electors qualified to be electors in the Municipal Councils elections of 1992; to make special provision regarding the boundaries of the electoral districts for the purposes of those elections; and for related purposes.

[Assented to 17th July, 1992]

Enactment

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows:—

PART I

PRELIMINARY

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Municipal Councils 1992 Elections (Special Provisions) Act, 1992.

Interpretation

2. In this Act—

Chap. 2:01

- "the Act" means the Representation of the People Act;
- "commencement date" means the date of the commencement of this Act;
- "Commission" and "electoral district" have the meanings respectively assigned to them by the Act;
- "expiration date" means the fourteenth day after the date of the Municipal Councils elections of 1992;
- "Municipal Corporation" has the meaning assigned to it by the Municipal Corporations Act;

"preliminary list" means a list published under section 3:

"the Rules" means the Registration Rules made under the Act.

PART II

PUBLICATION AND REVISION OF LISTS

Commission to publish list for 1992 elections

Act No. 21 of 1990

3. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of any other enactment relating to the preparation and publication of lists of persons qualified to be electors in an electoral district, the Commission, for the purposes of the Municipal Councils elections of 1992, shall publish on the

commencement date in respect of each Municipal Council electoral district a list of all persons qualified to be electors in that electoral district.

- (2) The list referred to in subsection (1) shall be the preliminary list of electors for that electoral district for the purposes of this Act.
- 4. Rules 51 and 58 to 65 of the Rules shall, for the Application of purposes of the Municipal Councils elections of 1992, electoral registration apply as though a period of electoral registration beginning on the commencement date and terminating on the expiration date, has been declared under section 30 of the Act.
- 5. For the purposes of the Election Rules made Application of under the Act, a reference to a revised list of electors to revised list shall be deemed to include a revised list made by virtue under this Act of the provisions of this Act.

PART III

Application of the Elections and Boundaries Commission (Local Government) Order, 1991

6. Notwithstanding the merger by the Municipal Application of Corporations (Amendment) Act, 1992 of the Municipal LN. No. 100 of 1991 Corporations listed in the Schedule, for the purpose of Schedule the Municipal Councils elections of 1992, the Elections and Boundaries Commission (Local Government) Order, 1991 made in pursuance of the Elections and Boundaries (Local Government) Act, shall have effect Chap. 25:50 for all purposes as though the Corporations so listed had not merged.

PART IV

MISCELLANEOUS

7. To the extent that it is inconsistent with other Inconsistency with written laws, other than the Constitution, this Act other written laws prevails.

Duration of Act

8. This Act shall remain in force for a period of twelve months and shall then expire without prejudice to anything lawfully done under it.
