Act No. 32 of 1966

AN ACT to authorise the payment of a gratuity and a pension to Alexander Holder, a former member of the Trinidad and Tobago Police Force.

[Assented to 13th September, 1966]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Alexander Holder Short title
(Special Gratuity and Pension) Act, 1966.

Payment of
gratuity and
pension

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary, authority is hereby given for the payment out of the Consolidated Fund to Alexander Holder, a former member of the Trinidad and Tobago Police Force, a gratuity in the sum of three thousand four hundred and thirty-four dollars and with effect from the 10th of May, 1965, a pension, payable monthly, at the rate of eight hundred and thirty-six dollars and twenty-five cents per annum.
