TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

**Act No. 30 of 1966**

[L.S.]

AN ACT to vary the sums appropriated to Heads of Expenditure set out in the Appropriation Act, 1966.

*[Assented to 30th August, 1966]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty <sup>Enactment</sup> by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance (Variation of <sup>Short title</sup> Appropriations) (No. 2) Act, 1966.

2. The sums appropriated to the several Heads of Expenditure set out in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1966, are hereby increased by the amounts specified in the Second Column of the said Part.

Reduction

3. The sums appropriated to the several Heads of Expenditure set out in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1966, are hereby reduced by the amounts specified in the Second Column of the said Part.

Sums appro-  
priated in respect  
of Heads set out  
in Parts II may  
be utilised

4. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Ordinance, 1959, the sum appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act 1966, and unissued at the commencement of this Act may be utilised for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase of the expenditure in respect of the Heads set out in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule.
