TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 21 of 1966

AN ACT for the Incorporation of the General Assembly of
the Church of God in Trinidad and Tobago

[Assented to 24th August, 1966]

WHEREAS there has been for many years established in
Trinidad and Tobago a religious association known as the
Missionary Board of the Church of God which is incor-
porated under the Act of the Legislative Assembly of the
State of Indiana in the United States of America and is

registered under Part X of the Companies Ordinance Chapter 31 No. 1 of the Laws of Trinidad and Tobago.

And whereas the said religious association operates and actively carries out its objects in Trinidad and Tobago under the name of the General Assembly of the Church of God in Trinidad and Tobago.

And whereas it is expedient that the said association should be incorporated under the name of the General Assembly of the Church of God in Trinidad and Tobago for the purpose of exercising the powers hereinafter set forth.

Enactment

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the General Assembly of the Church of God in Trinidad and Tobago (Incorporation) Act, 1966.

2. The Association known as the General Assembly of the Church of God in Trinidad and Tobago shall be and is hereby created a body corporate and by that name shall have perpetual succession, and may sue and be sued in the Courts of Justice in Trinidad and Tobago by that name, and shall have and use a common seal with power from time to time to change such seal.

3. The corporate body hereby created shall have power:—

- (a) to acquire by purchase, transfer, donation, exchange, devise, bequest, grant, gift, conveyance or howsoever otherwise, any real or personal property or any estate or interest therein;

- (b) to accept surrenders or re-conveyances and to enter into contracts;
- (c) subject to any restraint, reservation or condition contained in the document under which it shall have acquired title thereto, to sell, exchange, demise, mortgage, or otherwise dispose of and deal with all property which may for the time being be vested in or have been acquired by it.

4. All documents requiring the seal of the corporate body shall be sealed with its common seal in the presence of the Chairman and one of the Secretaries of the Executive Committee for the time being in office who shall both sign every such document, and such signing shall be prima facie evidence that the said seal was duly affixed and that the same is the lawful seal of the corporate body.

5. The corporate body shall at all times have a fixed address in Trinidad and Tobago for the service of documents on the corporate body and such address shall be registered with the Registrar General. All documents to be served on the corporate body may be served by leaving the same at or by sending the same by registered post to, the address so registered.

6. The properties specified in the Schedule to this Act and all other property real and personal of what nature soever now vested in any person or persons or Corporation for and on behalf of the General Assembly of the Church of God in Trinidad and Tobago shall be and are hereby vested in the said General Assembly of the Church of God in Trinidad and Tobago.

7. Nothing in this Act shall affect the rights of Her Majesty Her Heirs or Successors or of any bodies politic or corporate or of any other persons except such as are mentioned in this Act and those claiming by, from or under them.
