AN ORDINANCE to make provision for the payment of an annual allowance to Bobby Charles, former Messenger of the Trinidad Government Railways.

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Bobby Charles Pensions Ordinance, 1961.

Short title.

Authority to
pay Bobby
Charles an
annual
allowance
of \$360.00.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law relating to the grant of pensions, there shall be paid from the general revenue of the territory to Bobby Charles, former Messenger of the Trinidad Government Railways, an annual allowance at the rate of three hundred and sixty dollars with effect from the 1st day of September, 1949.

Passed in Council this fifteenth day of September, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-one.
