AN ORDINANCE to extend the term of office of the existing
Councillors of County Councils.

Commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment.
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of
Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Extension of Term Short title
of Councillors Ordinance, 1962.

(2) This Ordinance has effect from the 28th day of
February, 1962.

2. In the Ordinance "councillor" has the meaning assigned to it by section 2 of the County Councils Ordinance.

3. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (6) of section 82 of the County Councils Ordinance, the term of office of councillors which expires on the 28th day of February, 1962, is hereby extended to such day as the Governor may specify by Order published in the *Royal Gazette*.

Duration of

4. This Ordinance shall remain in force until the date specified in the Order made under section 3 of this Ordinance and shall then expire, but without prejudice to anything lawfully done hereunder.
