## Act No. 1 of 1964

[L.S.]

AN ACT to amend the Rent Restriction Ordinance,  
Ch. 27. No. 18

[Assented to 7th February, 1964]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, <sup>Enactment</sup>  
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and  
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and  
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Rent Restriction <sup>Short title</sup>  
(Amendment) Act, 1964.

Rent Restriction Ordinance amended  
Ch. 27. No. 18

2. The Rent Restriction Ordinance is hereby amended—
- (a) in section 2 thereof, by substituting for the definition of “prescribed date” the following:
    - ““prescribed date” means the 11th day of February, 1954;”;
  - (b) in the proviso to subsection (1) of section 3 thereof,
    - (i) by substituting for the full stop at the end of paragraph (c) the words “; or”; and
    - (ii) by adding immediately after paragraph (c) the following paragraph:
      - “(d) land let for the purpose of the erecting thereon by the tenant of a commercial or public building or a public or commercial building the property in which is or may become vested in the Corporation of the City of Port-of-Spain, the Corporation of the Borough of San Fernando or the Corporation of the Borough of Arima.”;
  - (c) in paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 9, by deleting all the words in the said paragraph occurring after the word “lettings”) in the eighth line thereof;
  - (d) in subsection (2) of section 11, by inserting immediately after the words “standard rents” occurring in the fourth line thereof the words “and on such conditions.”
