Act No. 34 of 1963

AN ACT to provide for Supplementary Appropriation for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1963.

[Assented to 30th December, 1963]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Third Supplementary Short title Appropriation Act, 1963.

2. A further sum not exceeding two million, two hundred and thirty-two thousand, nine hundred and fifty seven dollars shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the Consolidated Fund for the service of the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1963.

3. The sum charged by section 2 is hereby appropriated to the services and for the purposes expressed in the Schedule and shall be deemed to have been so appropriated from the 1st day of January, 1963.
