AN ACT to amend the Summary Ejectment Ordinance,
Ch. 27. No. 17.

[Assented to 7th February, 1964]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by ^{Enactment}
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House
of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the
authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Summary Ejectment ^{Short title}
(Amendment) Act, 1964.

2. Section 3 of the Summary Ejectment Ordinance is amended by substituting for the words "two hundred and forty" occurring in the fifth line thereof the words "twelve hundred."

3. Nothing in this Act shall be deemed to affect the prosecution of any action, matter or proceeding which may have been commenced or instituted before the coming into operation of this Act, and any action, matter or proceeding so commenced or instituted may be continued and prosecuted to a final judgment as if this Act had not been passed.
