AN ACT to provide for the extension of the term of office of the Mayors, Deputy Mayors, Councillors and Aldermen of the Municipality of the City of Port-of-Spain and of the Boroughs of San Fernando and Arima.

[1st November, 1962]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment  
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and  
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and  
by the authority of the same as follows :

1. This Act may be cited as the Municipal Corporations Short title and  
(Extension of Terms) Act, 1962, and shall come into opera- commencement  
tion on the 1st day of November, 1962.

Terms of office of Mayor, Deputy Mayor, Aldermen and councillors of the Corporation of the City of Port-of-Spain extended. Ch. 39. No. 1

2. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in subsection (2) of section 16 and subsection (1) of section 74 of the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance, the term of office of the person for the time being holding the office of Mayor is hereby extended to such day as the Governor-General may specify by Order published in the *Gazette*.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1) of section 18 and of subsection (1) of section 74 of the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance, the term of office of the person for the time being holding the office of Deputy Mayor is hereby extended to such day as the Governor-General may specify by Order published in the *Gazette*.

(3) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (5) of section 14 and subsection (1) of section 73 of the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance, the term of office of any alderman which expires on the 9th day of November, 1962, is hereby extended to such day as the Governor-General may specify by Order published in the *Gazette*.

(4) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1) of section 15 and section 72 of the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance, the term of office of any councillor which expires on the 3rd day of November, 1962, is hereby extended to such day as the Governor-General may specify by Order published in the *Gazette*.

Terms of office of mayor, deputy mayor, aldermen and councillors of the town of San Fernando extended. Ch. 39. No. 7

3. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 18 of the San Fernando Corporation Ordinance, the term of office of the persons for the time being holding the offices of Mayor and Deputy Mayor which expires on the 9th of November, 1962, is hereby extended to such day as the Governor-General may specify by Order published in the *Gazette*.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (5) of section 14 and subsection (1) of section 15 of the San Fernando Corporation Ordinance, the term of office of any alderman which expires on the 3rd day of November, 1962, is hereby extended to such day as the Governor-General may specify by Order published in the *Gazette*.

(3) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (6) of section 13 of the San Fernando Corporation Ordinance, the term of office of any councillor which expires on the 1st day of November, 1962, is hereby extended to such day as the Governor-General may specify by Order published in the *Gazette*.

4. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 18 of the Arima Corporation Ordinance, the term of office of the persons for the time being holding the offices of Mayor and Deputy Mayor which expires on the 9th day of November, 1962, is hereby extended to such day as the Governor-General may specify by Order published in the *Gazette*.

Terms of office of the mayor, deputy mayor, aldermen and councillors of the borough of Arima.  
Ch. 39. No. 11.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections (5) and (6) of section 14 and subsection (3) of section 6 of the Arima Corporation Ordinance, the term of office of any alderman which expires on the 3rd day of November, 1962, is hereby extended to such day as the Governor-General may specify by Order published in the *Gazette*.

(3) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 13 of the Arima Corporation Ordinance, the term of office of any councillor which expires on the 1st day of November, 1962, is hereby extended to such day as the Governor-General may specify by Order published in the *Gazette*.

5. This Act shall remain in force until the date specified by Order made by the Governor-General and shall then expire.
