AN ACT to amend the Queen's Hall Ordinance  
(No. 14 of 1959)

*[Assented to 10th July, 1963]*

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment  
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House  
of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the  
authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Queen's Hall Short title  
(Amendment) Act, 1963.

Sections 2 and 6  
of the Queen's  
Hall Ordinance  
amended

2. The Queen's Hall Ordinance is hereby amended:

(a) in section 2 by substituting for the definition of "Minister" the following:

" "Minister" means the member of Cabinet to whom responsibility for the subject of culture has been assigned."

(b) in section 6—

- (i) by deleting the words "three months" occurring in the second line of paragraph (b) of subsection (1) thereof; and
- (ii) by inserting the words "except with the consent of the Minister" immediately after the words "Provided that" occurring in subsection (3) thereof.
