TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 47 of 1970

[L.S.]

AN ACT to amend the Appropriation Act, 1970.

[Assented to 14th December, 1970]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by ^{Enactment.}
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by
the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance (Variation of ^{Short title.}
Appropriation) (No. 3) Act, 1970.

Construction.

2. In this Act and in any other enactment, a reference to the Appropriation Act, 1970, shall be construed as a reference to that Act as for the time being varied, or otherwise amended by any Finance (Variation of Appropriation) Act, passed before this or that other enactment.

Increase in certain Heads of Expenditure. Act No. 40 of 1969.

3. The sums appropriated to the several Heads of Expenditure set out in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1970, are hereby increased by the amounts specified in the Second Column of the said Part I.

Reductions in certain Heads of Expenditure.

4. The sums appropriated to the several Heads of Expenditure set out in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1970, are hereby reduced by the amounts specified in the Second Column of the said Part II.

Sums appropriated in respect of Heads set out in Part II may be utilised. Ord. No. 20 of 1959.

5. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Ordinance, 1959, the sums appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1970, and unissued at the commencement of this Act may be utilised for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase of the expenditure in respect of the Heads set out in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule.
