**Act No. 20 of 1970**

AN ACT to authorize the computation of the period of service from 1st November, 1928 to 31st May, 1941, of William Henry Carter for pension purposes.

*[Assented to 26th June, 1970]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, <sup>Enactment</sup> by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows: —

**1.** This Act may be cited as the William Henry Carter <sup>Short title</sup> (Service for Pension Purposes) Act, 1970.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary the period of teaching service of William Henry Carter a retired non-graduate Master/Lecturer II, St. Mary's College, from 1st November, 1928 to 31st May, 1941, and his period of service with the Old Age Pensions Department from 1st June, 1941, to 31st March, 1942, shall be taken into account in computing his service for pension purposes in accordance with the Assisted Secondary School Teachers' Pensions Act, 1963, as if the period of service with the Old Age Pensions Department was teaching service within the meaning of that Act.
