**Act No. 21 of 1970**

AN ACT to make special provision for the grant of a gratuity to Gwendoline Crawford, formerly employed in the Ministry of Health as a temporary Ward Assistant.

*[Assented to 26th June, 1970]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Gwendoline Crawford Short title (Gratuity) Act, 1970.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law relating to the grant of gratuity there shall be paid from the Consolidated Fund to Gwendoline Crawford, in respect of her service as a Temporary Ward Assistant (Now Nurse's Aide) in the Ministry of Health, a gratuity of one thousand, three hundred and seventy-two dollars.
