Act No. 33 of 1971

AN ACT to amend the Police Service Act, 1965.

[Assented to 12th November, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by <sup>Enactment</sup> and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Police Service (Amend- Short title  
ment) Act, 1971.

2. The Sixth Schedule to the Police Service Act, 1965, is amended by inserting immediately after subsection (4) of section 3 thereof the following new subsections—

“(4A) For the purposes of subsection (4), a period of full-time service as a member of the Special Reserve Police shall be counted as service in the Police Service if it terminates not earlier than the day immediately preceding the commencement of service in the Police Service, save that no such period of full-time service shall be taken into account in computing any pension thereunder.

(4B) In subsection (4A) “full-time service” means service remunerated at a monthly paid rate and includes any period of absence from duty on leave with full pay.”
