Act No. 25 of 1971

AN ACT to provide for the payment of a gratuity to Ogeeran, formerly employed in the Ministry of Local Government and Social Welfare as a labourer and attached to the Victoria County Council.

[Assented to 3rd September, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by ^{Enactment} and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Ogeeran (Gratuity) ^{Short title} Act, 1971.

Authority to
pay gratuity
to Ogeeran

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary, authority is hereby given for the payment out of the Consolidated Fund to Ogeeran, former labourer in the Ministry of Local Government, of a gratuity in the sum of one thousand five hundred and forty-four dollars and forty cents.
