AN ACT to provide for the payment of a gratuity to Joycelyn Gibson-McKnight, formerly employed as a Temporary Nurse's Aide in the Ministry of Health.

[Assented to 3rd September, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment} by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Joycelyn Gibson- ^{Short title} McKnight (Gratuity) Act, 1971.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary, authority is hereby given for the payment out of the Consolidated Fund to Joycelyn Gibson-McKnight, formerly a Temporary Nurse's Aide in the Ministry of Health, of a gratuity in the sum of nine hundred and seventy-two dollars.
