Act No. 20 of 1968

AN ACT to make special provision for the grant of a contract gratuity to Irving Charles, formerly employed as a Messenger in the Ministry of Health.

[Assented to 12th August, 1968]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment} by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Irving Charles (Contract ^{Short Title} Gratuity) Act, 1968.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law relating to the grant of gratuity, there may be paid from the Consolidated Fund to Irving Charles, formerly employed as a Messenger in the Ministry of Health, in respect of his services as a Messenger, a gratuity of two thousand two hundred and eighty dollars.
