TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO
Act No. 16 of 1968

AN ACT to make provision for superannuation benefits and compensation for loss of office in respect of Jeremiah Smith a former employee of the Railway Department.

[Assented to 29th May, 1968]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment} by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Jeremiah Smith (Pension, ^{Short title} Gratuity and Compensation for Loss of Office) Act, 1968.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any other law relating to the granting of pensions or to the basis on which the pension, gratuity or allowance of any public officer shall be computed, it is hereby declared that for the purpose of computing any pension, gratuity and compensation for loss of office payable to him, Jeremiah Smith shall be deemed to have been—

- (a) appointed to the office of Junior Permanent Way Inspector, Railway Department, with effect from the 15th August, 1961; and
- (b) a prescribed public officer under the Public Transport Service Act, 1965 eligible for superannuation benefits and entitled to compensation for loss of office under the Public Transport Service (Compensation for Loss of Office) Regulations, 1966.
