AN ACT to amend the Cremation Ordinance,
Ch. 12. No. 20.

[Assented to 16th June, 1970]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment.}
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Cremation (Amend- ^{Short title.}
ment) Act, 1970.

2. The Cremation Ordinance is amended by repealing and replacing section 7 as follows—

"Crematorium
Site.

7. (1) No person shall construct a Crematorium within one hundred yards of any dwelling house nor within fifty yards of any highway, nor in the consecrated part of the burial ground of any cemetery under the charge or control of any Burial Authority.

Pyre Site.

(2) No person shall burn any human remains by the Pyre method within such distance of a dwelling house or any highway as may be prescribed."
