Act No. 4 of 1986

AN ACT to amend the Cremation Act, Chap. 30:51

[Assented to 14th March, 1986]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago Enactment
as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Cremation (Amendment) Short title
Act, 1986.

Chap. 30:51
amended

2. The Cremation Act is amended as follows:

(a) in section 2 by—

- (i) inserting immediately after the word “Borough” occurring in the first line of the definition of “Burial Authority”, the words “or County”;
- (ii) including in appropriate sequence a definition of “Minister” as follows: “ “Minister” means the Minister to whom responsibility for Local Government is assigned;”;

(b) in section 4 by—

- (i) inserting immediately after the word “with” occurring in the second line of subsection (1) the words “permission granted under the Town and Country Planning Act, and”;
- (ii) substituting for the words “or Health and Local Government” occurring immediately after the word “Minister” in the third line thereof, the words “to whom responsibility for Environmental Health is assigned,”;

(c) in section 7 by substituting for subsection (1) the following:

“ (1) No person may construct a crematorium except within such a distance from a dwelling house or highway as may be permitted under the Town and Country Planning Act.”;

(d) in section 10 by including a new paragraph (f) as follows:

“(f) uses a crematorium for the burning of anything other than human remains.”;

(e) in section 11 by inserting immediately after the word “fees” occurring in the second line thereof, the words “approved by the Minister”.
