No. 18.—1854.

“18 of 1854 is repealed by Ordinance 16 of 1874.”

BE it enacted by HIS EXCELLENCY the GOVERNOR, by and with the advice and consent of the Council of Government, That where any Ordinance repealing in whole or in part any previous Ordinance is itself repealed, such last repeal shall not revive the Ordinance or Provisions before repealed, unless words be added reviving such Ordinance or Provisions.
