THE CREMATION ACT, CHAP. 30:51

REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CREMATION ACT

THE CREMATION (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1986

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Cremation (Amendment) Citation Regulations, 1986.

2. The Cremation Regulations are amended as follows:

Chap. 30:51  
amended

- (a) in regulation 3, by substituting for the words “of Health” occurring in the last line of paragraph (d) thereof, the words “to whom responsibility for Environmental Health is assigned”;
- (b) in regulation 9, by—
  - (i) substituting for the words “a quarter of a mile” occurring in the second line of paragraph (b) of subsection (1), the words “1.6 kilometres”;
  - (ii) substituting for the words “Planning and Development” occurring in the fifth line of subsection (2), the words “Environmental Health”;
  - (iii) inserting immediately after the word “course” occurring in the fifth line of paragraph (b) of subsection (3), the words “not approved for that purpose”;
  - (iv) by deleting subsection (4);
- (c) in regulation 10, by—
  - (i) substituting for the words “of Health” occurring in the first line of paragraph (c) of subsection (1), the words “to whom responsibility for Environmental Health is assigned”;
  - (ii) substituting for the words “one-half mile” occurring in the first line of paragraph (a) of subsection (2), the words “0.8 kilometres” and for the words “one hundred yards” occurring in the second line of this paragraph the words “30 metres”;
  - (iii) substituting for the words “County Medical Officer of Health” occurring in the first line of paragraph 2(d) the words “Minister to whom responsibility for Environmental Health is assigned”;
- (d) in regulation 11, by adding immediately after the word “officer” occurring in the second line of paragraph (c) of subsection (1), the words “or any other person designated by him”;
- (e) in regulation 12, by deleting the words “to the Minister and” occurring in the seventh line thereof;
- (f) in regulation 17, by inserting immediately after the word “Minister” occurring in the fourth line of subregulation (1), the words “responsible for Local Government the Minister to whom responsibility for Environmental Health is assigned”;

- (g) in regulation 21, by inserting immediately after the word "Minister" occurring in the third line thereof, the words "to whom responsibility for Environmental Health is assigned";
- (h) by deleting regulation 22;
- (i) in regulation 23, by—
- (i) substituting for subregulation (2) the following:
 

“(2) Where the Crematorium Authority—

    - (a) fails to comply with subregulation (1),  
or
    - (b) operates a crematorium under conditions in which, in the opinion of the Minister responsible for Environmental Health, a health hazard exists,

that Minister may, in the case of paragraph (a) close a crematorium upon giving not less than one week's notice thereof to the Crematorium Authority or in the case of paragraph (b) close the crematorium immediately, either by advertisement in a daily newspaper or by having notice affixed to the entrance to the crematorium.”;
  - (ii) deleting subregulation (5);
- (j) in regulation 29, by—
- (i) deleting the word "either" occurring in the sixth line of subregulation (1) and by deleting all the words occurring immediately after the word "ashes" in the eighth line thereof;
  - (ii) deleting all the words occurring immediately after the word "interred" occurring in the fifth line of subregulation (2) and by substituting for them the following words:
 

“in the land adjoining the cremation on the site reserved for the burial of ashes”;
  - (iii) deleting subregulation (4).
