AN ORDINANCE for authorising the application to the Establishment of a system of underground Sewerage, within the town of Port of Spain, of moneys to be raised under an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance for raising moneys to be applied to the erection of certain Public Buildings," and for otherwise amending the said Ordinance.

**W**HEREAS an Ordinance was passed in Council on the twenty-second day of August, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four, entitled "An Ordinance for raising moneys to be applied to the erection of certain Public Buildings;" and it was by the said Ordinance provided, that the moneys to be raised under the authority of the same, after deducting any expenses attending the execution thereof, should be applied to the erection of the several buildings mentioned in the said Ordinance: And whereas no moneys have been hitherto raised under the authority of the said Ordinance, but the several Buildings mentioned in the said Ordinance, with the exception of a gaol in the town of San Fernando, have been erected, or are now in the course of erection, and the moneys necessary for erecting the same have been provided from the general revenues of the Colony: And whereas another Ordinance was passed in Council, on the first day of October, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six, entitled, "An Ordinance for establishing a system of underground Sewerage within the Town of Port of Spain:" And whereas it is expedient that authority should be given to apply the moneys to be raised under the said Ordinance, of the twenty-second day of August, to the defraying of the expenses of establishing such system of underground Sewerage, and that the said Ordinance should be otherwise amended: Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Council of Government as follows:

1. The moneys to be raised under the said Ordinance of the twenty-second day of August, may be applied to the paying of the expenses of establishing a system of underground sewerage, within the Town of Port of Spain, under the authority of the said Ordinance of the first day of October.

2. So much of the said Ordinance of the twenty-second day of August, as directs that the Debentures to be issued under the said Ordinance, shall be redeemable on the expiration of twenty years from the day of granting the same, and that for the gradual redemption of the same there shall be established a sinking fund, shall be and the same is hereby repealed.

3. Of the Debentures to be issued under the authority of the said Ordinance of the twenty-second day of August, Debentures to the amount of one thousand five hundred pounds sterling shall be redeemed on the fifteenth day of July, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one, and on the same day in each year thereafter ensuing, until all such Debentures shall have been redeemed, and the particular Debentures redeemable in each year, shall be determined by lot, in such manner as the Governor may from time to time direct; and notice of the distinguishing numbers of the Debentures so redeemable, shall be given in the *Royal Gazette*, on or before the fifteenth day of March, of the year in which the same shall be redeemable, and the interest on every such Debenture shall cease from the day on which the same shall be so redeemable.

Passed in Council this second day of May, in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine.
