AN ORDINANCE to amend Ordinance No. 6. of 1870, intituled "An Ordinance with regard to Education."

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council, as follows:

1. This Ordinance shall be read and construed as one with the Ordinance No. 6 of 1870, intituled "An Ordinance with regard to Education." Construction.

Section 2 is repealed by Ordinance of 1882.

Section 3 is repealed by Ordinances 23 of 1878 and 20 of 1881.

School fees
to be charged.

4. For each child attending any school of primary education maintained from public funds there shall be charged a school fee of not less than threepence per week. When two or more children of the same family are attending school the fee for the second child shall be not less than twopence, and for the third child or any additional child not less than one penny per week.

enforced no
aid will be
granted.

5. No school shall receive aid from public funds the managers of which do not charge payment of school fees at rates not less than those enumerated in the last preceding section; and do not enforce and obtain payment of such proportion of those fees as may from time to time be prescribed by any regulation of the Board of Education.
