AN ORDINANCE to amend Ordinance No. 24 of 1875, intituled "An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 6 of 1870, intituled an Ordinance with regard to Education."

WHEREAS it is expedient to hold out inducement to parents of children attending schools of primary instruction to compound by reduced quarterly payments in advance for the weekly fee fixed by Ordinance 24 of 1875: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council, as follows:—

1. A quarterly payment in advance of two shillings, one shilling and fourpence, or eightpence respectively, shall be an alternative payment for the fee of threepence, twopence, or one penny a week respectively fixed by the said Ordinance.

Passed in Council this tenth day of November, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six.
