AN ORDINANCE to render applicable the provisions of "The Public Land-Charges Ordinance, 1879," to the Diego Martin Water Rate.

(L.S.) S. FREELING, *Governor*.

22nd August, 1881.

WHEREAS by a certain Ordinance passed in Council on the 1st day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one, and intituled "An Ordinance for vesting in Her Majesty certain water works for supplying the village of Diego Martin with water," No. 25, for 1861, a yearly rate of one shilling for every pound of the annual rent or value of all houses within the village of Diego Martin is directed to be raised, levied and paid to Her Majesty the Queen, and whereas it is expedient that the provisions of "The Public Land-Charges Ordinance, 1879," should be made applicable to the recovery of the said rate: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council as follows:

1. The provisions of "The Public Land-Charges Ordinance, 1879," are hereby declared to be applicable to the rate imposed by the above recited Ordinance.

2. The enactments specified in the schedule to this Ordinance are hereby repealed: Provided that any arrear of the said rate due on the commencement of this Ordinance shall be recoverable in accordance with the provisions of "The Public Land-Charges Ordinance, 1879," in the same manner as if the amount of such arrear increased at the rate of twenty pounds per centum were due and payable on the day of such commencement.

Passed in Council this sixteenth day of August, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one.
