AN ORDINANCE to amend the Ordinance No. 5 for 1873, intituled "An Ordinance to regulate the Salary of Officers Administering the Government of Trinidad and for other purposes."

(L.S.) S. FREELING, *Governor*.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council as follows:—

1. This Ordinance shall be read and construed as one with the Ordinance No. 5 of 1873, intituled "An Ordinance to regulate the Salary of Officers administering the Government of Trinidad, and for other purposes," and herein referred to as "the principal Ordinance." Construction.

2. Notwithstanding any thing contained to the contrary in the fourth, fifth, or sixth sections of the principal Ordinance, the Governor and such persons who from time to time constitute his staff respectively, shall receive their full salaries during any period or periods of absence on leave not exceeding six weeks in any one year. Governor and staff to receive full salary.
