

5. The Fisheries Company shall in each month deliver at the place of business of the person carrying on marketing business with whom it has dealt, a statement of the volume and value of all sales of diesel oil and gas oil for the preceding month, at the retail price fixed by paragraph 4 together with a statement of the volume and value of all sales made by it for that month. Fisheries Company to make monthly statements

6. (1) For the purposes of this Order, the Fisheries Company shall keep proper records of accounts and of the volume and value of petroleum products sold by it during each month. Fisheries Company to keep records

(2) The Minister may authorise any employee of his Ministry to inspect the records of the Fisheries Company in order to verify the accuracy of the statement made pursuant to paragraph 5.

7. This Order is deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 1975. Commencement

THE CONSERVATION OF WILD LIFE (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2)
REGULATIONS, 1975

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Conservation of Wild Life (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1975. Citation

2. The Second Schedule to the Conservation of Wild Life Ordinance, 1958 is amended by adding to Part II thereof the following:— Second Schedule to the Conservation of Wild Life Ordinance, 1958 amended. Ord. No. 16 of 1958

“*Amazona Amazonica Amazonica*—Lim or Common Amazon Parrot
Corbeau, Common Town (Coragyps)
Ramier or Pigeon (all kinds).”

3. These Regulations shall have effect from the 1st day of October, 1975. Commencement
