AN ORDINANCE for registering certain Chapels and Buildings for the Solemnization of Marriages.

ROB. W. KEATE.

WHEREAS an Ordinance was passed in Council on the first day of August in the Year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, entitled “An Ordinance to amend the Law with regard to the Solemnization and Registration of Marriages,” by which Ordinance it is provided that the several churches, chapels and buildings mentioned in the Schedule A to the said Ordinance shall be considered for all the purposes of the said Ordinance as buildings registered for the Solemnization of Marriages: And whereas before and at the time of the passing of the said Ordinance the several churches and buildings mentioned in the Schedule to this Ordinance were used for Solemnizing Marriages: Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council as follows:

1. The several chapels and places mentioned in the Schedule to this Ordinance shall be considered as buildings registered for the Solemnization of Marriages within the meaning of the said Ordinance of the first day of August aforesaid in the same manner as if the same had been mentioned in the Schedule A to the said Ordinance.

Passed in Council this first day of February in the Year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four.
