AN ORDINANCE for extending the provisions of an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance with regard to Roads."

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council as follows :—

1. It shall be lawful for the Governor with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council by resolution from time to time to make order for the setting out and making of such roads from and to such parts of the island as the Governor and Council may from time to time see fit ; and upon any such resolution being made all the Provisions of the Ordinance of the twentieth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, entitled "An Ordinance with regards to Roads," shall be taken to extend and apply to the road mentioned in such resolution in the same manner as if such road had been expressly named in the said Ordinance.

Passed in Council this twenty-first day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine.
