## AN ORDINANCE for the Incorporation of the Roman Catholic Archbishop of Port of Spain.

*4th August, 1870.*

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council, as follows:

1. The Most Reverend Hyacinth Joachim Louis Gonin, the Roman Catholic Archbishop in this Island, and his successors in office or the Roman Catholic dignitary for the time being having the supreme ecclesiastical jurisdiction in this Island, in the Roman Catholic Church, shall be a body corporate, and have the name of "The Roman Catholic Archbishop of Port of Spain," and by that name shall have perpetual succession, and shall have full power to purchase, take, hold and enjoy all lands, messuages and hereditaments of what nature or kind soever in perpetuity or for a term of life or years, and also all manner of goods and chattels whatsoever, and may sue and be sued in all Courts of Justice, and before all magistrates in this Island, and shall and may have and use a common seal, and the said seal may from time to time break, change, alter or make anew, as to the said corporate body may seem fit.

Passed in Council this first day of August, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy.
