AN ORDINANCE to amend "The Dogs Ordinance,  
1895." (7—1895.)

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and  
Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legis-  
lative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Dogs Short Title.  
Construction.  
Ordinance, 1898," and shall be read as one with "The  
Dogs Ordinance, 1895," hereinafter called the Principal  
Ordinance.

2. On the 1st July, 1898, there shall be paid for each Alteration of

dog license the sum of Four Shillings and two pence  
in the Boroughs of Port-of-Spain, San Fernando and  
Arima, and Two Shillings and one penny outside such

Boroughs, and such license shall expire on the 14th of January, 1899. Subject as herein provided Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance shall be read as if the words "15th of January" had been inserted therein instead of the words "30th June."

3. Subject as aforesaid Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the words "Eight Shillings and four pence in the Boroughs of Port-of-Spain, San Fernando and Arima, and Four Shillings and two pence outside such Boroughs" for the words "Four Shillings and two pence."

4. Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the words "A sum not less than five shillings and not more than twenty shillings" for the words "a sum of twenty shillings."
