AN ORDINANCE to amend "The Lunatics Ordinance, 1877."

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance shall be construed as one with "The Lunatics Ordinance, 1877," and may be cited as "The Lunatics Ordinance, 1900."

2. Any Stipendiary Justice of the Peace may with the sanction of the Governor by warrant under his hand order the transfer of any lunatic or lunatics from any Colonial Lunatic Asylum to any other Colonial Lunatic Asylum and from any Criminal Lunatic Asylum to any other Criminal Lunatic Asylum.

Passed in Council this Third day of September, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred.
