AN ORDINANCE to amend the Port-of-Spain House
Tax Ordinance, 1899. (No. 12—1899.)

WHEREAS it is expedient to extend the time for the hearing by the Stipendiary Justice of the Peace having jurisdiction in that behalf of objections to the assessment made by the Town Assessor of houses or lands in the Town of Port-of-Spain for the year 1900, and also the time for the delivery of the House Rate Book to the Town Clerk: Be it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Port-of-Spain House Tax Amendment Ordinance, 1900." Title.
2. This Ordinance shall be construed as one with Construction. "The Port-of-Spain House Tax Ordinance, 1899."
3. It shall be lawful for the Stipendiary Justice of the Peace having jurisdiction in the Town of Port-of- Extension of time for objections.

No. 12. *Port-of-Spain House Rates.* 1900.

Spain, on some day to be appointed by such Stipendiary Justice, such day not being later than the 21st day of May, 1900, to hear and determine all objections duly made to the assessment of any house or parcel of land in the town of Port-of-Spain in respect of the year 1900.

Delivery of
rate book.

4. It shall be lawful for the Assessor to deliver to the Town Clerk and Treasurer the House Rate Book for the year 1900 on or before the 31st day of May, 1900.
